Issuance of PPL

a) Requirements:-

- 1. Age not less than 17 years.
- 2. Medical fitness (Class I / II).
- 3. Letter from an approved Flying School
- 4. Security Clearance.
- 5. PPL Theory examination result sheet issued by CAASL
- 6. Enroll with a Approved Flying School and undergo flying training successful completion of ground school and flying experience
- 7. Flying experience as "C" bellow.
- 8. English Language Proficiency. (Level 4 or higher)
- 9. Flying school recommendation for Examinations / skill test

b) Supportive documents to be submitted:-

- 1. Duly completed Application for Examination of PPL (CAA/PL/E/01) through flying school.
- 2. Duly completed evaluation form for English Language Proficiency check (CAA/PL/E/08)
- 3. Letter from an Approved Flying School

c) Flying experience:-

For Private Pilot Licence.

- Total 40 hrs or 35 hours if completed during a course of approved training
- 10 hrs of Solo flight time appropriate to the class rating sought
- 05 hrs Solo Cross country flight time with at least one cross flight totaling not less than 270km (150 NM) with two full stop landings at two different aerodromes.
- ➢ Instrument 05 hrs.

d) Procedure:-

- 1. Register with the computerized Licensing System through www.caa.lk
- 2. Create the user profile and add the PPL issuance application form.
- 3. If you need any assistance to create the profile or add new application, press the "Help" button.
- 4. Visit the Personnel Licensing Section with the original documents and make the relevant payment to commence the process of evaluation of the application.
- 5. The requirements for issuance of Private Pilot Licences have been published in *Implementing Standards 051* which you can download from the website.
- 6. Submit Personnel Particulars form No. CAA/PL/M/12 to obtain Security Clearance
- 7. Submit application for Medical Examination under a CAA Medical Examiner.
- 8. Appear for following examinations at CAASL.
 - > PPL Technical Examination.
 - Radio Telephony Test
 - English Language Proficiency check
 - > Flying test with appropriate type of Aircraft.
- 6. Obtain SPL. *If you don't have valid SPL & see the procedure for obtaining of SPL.*
- 7. Finally collect letter for flight test and complete it, Submit Examiner report & ATC observer's report.
- 8. Check the status of the application through your profile in the Licensing System
