Provision of GDS Connections

In terms of the Air Navigation (Special Provisions) Act No 55 of 1992, any person or organization who desires to carry on the business of air transportation in Sri Lanka is required to obtain an Air Transport Providers (Passenger) Licence issued by the Director General of Civil Aviation.

It is observed that there are some travel agencies in Sri Lanka who carry out the business of air transport without obtaining the licence from the DGCA.

Therefore you are hereby instructed to provide GDS connections only to a person or organization who poses a valid Air Transport Providers (Passenger) Licence issued by the Director General of Civil Aviation.

The GDS Providers are strictly instructed to adhere to the above instructions and to comply accordingly.
